Let me present to you a brief report on the progress in Bwesa

1. Water tank

This is already in use and the benefits are that our pupils can now have clean water and can use it to accompany their packed food as well as washing hands and their containers, they no longer suffer travelling a long distance to fetch water, candidates who sleep at school no longer wake up at 4:00 am to fetch water and the teachers who stay at school are sure of atleast a twenty litre Jerican of clean rain water a day.



2. Solar power

This was installed in our small house and we have light inside the rooms and outside for security, can charge our mobile telephones, charge the laptop and use other minor electric gadgets.



3. Motorcycle

The motorcycle (Second hand) was bought and has helped us a lot in pastoral work especially visiting distant outstations, anointing the sick, visiting the orphans, the poor and the elderly.

4. The Orphans

These were assisted to pay their school fees and are in their different schools without tension for school fees. At the end of the school term, we shall send you their reports from the schools and a general report of their progress.

5. St. Theresa's Day (October 01, 2012)

This was celebrated at St. Theresa Primary School and to mark the occasion, 6 pupils from the school were baptised and 54 received their first Communion.
